## Hindemith bassoon sonate

Paul Hindemith is a well-known Jews German composer. He wrote one of the best sonata for bassoon and make it very unique. Hindemith bassoon sonata consist of 2 movement with it own uniqueness. The first movement are on it own dependent style. It is very unique on how each part of the piano and bassoon have it own lyrical soloist part and embarkment of playing. while to be more exciting the second movement are much more interesting. The second movement of bassoon and piano is a sequence of three section which are thematically independent of each other, like character changes emotion and perspective in life. The second movement are a bit radically challenging in counting and rhythm for the bassoon. Hindemith wrote this piece in the era that people stop listening to his music as his been label a bad influence. However, this piece has caught the love of most bassoon player because of how melodious, full of character and interesting emotion changes.

Jan Anton Kozeluh Concerto in C Major for bassoon and Piano

Jan Anton Kozeluh was music teacher and church musician in prague. He had wrote numerous of concerto for all kind of instrument and that is included the bassoon. This piece concist of 3 movement with allelgro, langsam and vivace. The movement start with a very pride and lyrical bassoon part in the allegro. With most of the hard running passage and tricky fingering. The second movement is more melodious for the bassoon with lot of beautiful passage. As for the last movement, the piece end with a very fast movement, loud and proud sound as to resemble a parade.
