CFA2210 Collaborative Music Ensembles Audition Requirements

Any member of the ensemble who does not have at least one year of active membership in a CFA or residential hall music group must submit a video recording for their audition.

Audition Pieces:

- Fast Piece
 - Perform one fast piece that showcases your technical skills and agility. This should be a piece where you can demonstrate your proficiency with quick tempos and complex passages.
- Slow Piece
 - Perform one slow piece that highlights your musicality and expressive abilities. Choose a piece that allows you to showcase your control over phrasing, tone, and dynamics.

Additional Requirements:

- Introduction
 - Start your video with a brief introduction. State your name, the instrument you play, and the pieces you will be performing.

Recording Guidelines:

- Ensure that your video has clear audio and visual quality.
- Position the camera so that your full range of motion is visible.
- Perform in a quiet environment to avoid background noise.

Submission Guidelines:

- Combine the recordings (if taken separately) into one video only.
- Label the file as follows: <Name>_<Group Name>_<CFA2210 Video Auditions>
- Submit the video file to the Group Leader. The Group Leader should consolidate all
 videos into one folder in a shareable online drive (e.g. Google Drive, Dropbox, etc).
 Ensure that the folder is set to be accessible by anyone. Copy the link and paste it in
 the application form.
